#### **NEW EQUIPMENT**

#### Kenwood TS50

Peter Alexander, VK2PA, has just had the opportunity of testing this new HF Transceiver designed specifically for Mobile and/or Fixed operation. The transceiver was loaned to him by Ian, VK2XU of DX Engineering who represesnts Kenwood here in Port Macquarie.

This HF transceiver, which is no larger than a 2 metre mobile set, delivers up to 100 watts of power on all bands 1.8 thru 28 MHz. The receiver has full general coverage from 500 KHz to 30 MHz. All modes, CW, SSB, AM and FM. Some of the features that Peter high-lighted in his evaluation were:

- \* Two VFO's
- \* Digital mode capability including Packet, RTTY and Amtor.
- \* 100 memories with memory protect.
- \* Scanning facilities.

- \* Full QSK on CW plus programmable delay.
- \* Easy to read large back lit display with brilliance adjustment.
- \* Stability excellent.

As most of you know, Peter has a preference for CW, so much of his evaluation was conducted in this mode. To quote..."I have had experience with Ten Tec Equipment and the Kenwood TS 930 and TS 440 which have excellent full break in (QSK) and the desire deying shape on CW. I found the TS 50 keying and QSK and the keying shape, rise and decay time, excellent, analysed on the CRO and from on air reports, no key clicks or thumps at the three power levels." (10, 50 or 100 watts)....."I have been working through to Europe on 14 MHz CW with 10 watts and no problem on 7 MHZ with 50 watts. Reducing power from 100 or 50 watts to 10 watts for VK contacts, the difference is hardly noticed."

"For a transceiver that measures 180 by 69 by 270 mm and weighs only 2.9 Kg if it ever went wrong you could send it for repair in a jiffy bag almost......I am very impressed."

One final feature, if you don't operate the transceiver for 180 minutes it will switch it self off. A great battery saver if used mobile and you can also disable the microphone press-to-talk switch and store in memory and stop the kids from going on the air when your back is turned."
